## 短冊に願いごとを書こう!!

Write your wishes on “Tanzaku”

七夕とは、「7月7日の夜に限り、年に一度だけ、織姫と彦星が天の川を渡って会うことができる」との言い伝えにちなんで、短冊に願いごとを書いて笹に飾る日本の伝統行事です。

Tanabata is a traditional Japanese festival in which people write their wishes on Tanzaku, strips of paper and hang them on bamboo poles. It is based on the legend that “Orihime and Hikoboshi can meet across the Milky Way only once a year on the night of July 7th.”

The wishes collected through the Domestic Pavilions “Tanabata” Celebration will also be linked to organizer events “One World, One Planet.”. The wishes will be part of a special production that will begin on July 7, and will shine in the night sky according to the wishes gathered.

“One World, One Planet.” is currently developing the “#WISH\_EXPO” system, which allows visitors to submit their wishes and participate in the ceremony via the web and the Virtual Expo application.
